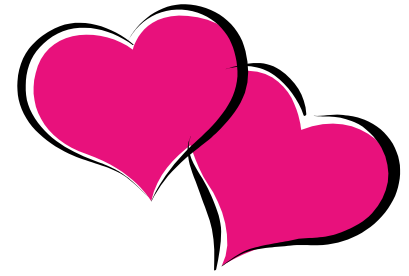

Just a reminder, classrooms will be going outside if the temperature is above 32 degrees. As stated in the handbook,

"We believe that children need fresh air and exercise daily. Outdoor play is scheduled, weather permitting. During the winter months, outdoor schedules are planned with limited time frames along with time to play in our gym area. All children will go outside unless the temperature is below 32 degrees or if the wind chill is below zero degrees. In the heat of the summer, playground times are scheduled for early morning or late afternoons. Children do not go outside if the temperature is above 100 degrees. **Children who are too sick to go outside, are too sick to be in childcare.**"

Please remember to bring winter clothing and jackets to keep in their cubbies.
