Bible Point - Encourage each other to believe in Jesus

Key Verse: But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness. - Hebrews 3:13

We're called to encourage each other daily in our faith (Acts 11:19-26). Strengthen your family's faith learning and growth at home with this easy idea:

- Share a time that each of your children did something to encourage you. Maybe one of them gave you a hug when you needed it most or told you how much he or she loves you.
- As a family, talk about simple ways people offer encouragement—such as writing a friendly note, giving hugs during a difficult time, being a good listener, or offering to help out.
- Talk about why it's important to encourage each other and other Christians in our faith. Commit to one way you can encourage people this week.
