## Bible Point: Jesus fulfilled God's promise.

Key Verse: All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: 'The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel'—which means, 'God with us.' - Matthew 1:22-23
